I do not know if you are still attached counsel or not, but I am writing you before I reach out to AVSA Warlick directly. I received the 30-May-23 transcript today and confirmed that the FBI claims my passport was "revoked" well prior to my departure to Zambia. This is the first reliable statement I have seen of the timing and conditions of "revocation." It also tells me that Corey Zachman can probably track down when it was revoked. The last piece of the puzzle is then what problems revocation poses for re-issuance. This is what I have been after since early 2023. Last week I had Eve send me the Dysart communications to prove it. Dysart could have grabbed the passport - instead he lied. I thank you for tracking down what happened to it after it was seized. The information in that passport directly refutes statements on 30-May-23. I will not plead guilty until the record is corrected. I will continue to work towards a clarification of my expatriation status - both with the state department [passport revocation/re-issuance] and with the sentencing particulars as it pertains to Thai law. I do value your experience and skill in dealing with the court and with the united states. I appreciate your ethics. I am not confident we have the same goals and priorities and I am quite confident our values differ. I will leave it up to you to determine if we continue. -e
